# Background

- ▶ Title 7, Chapter 5, Section 25 - Industrial Pretreatment Program
- ▶ National Pretreatment Program Objectives
  - ▶ Prevent interference and pass through
  - ▶ Improve opportunities to reclaim and recycle wastewaters and biosolids
  - ▶ Provide equitable distribution of costs
  - ▶ Provide and promote the health, safety, and welfare of citizens
  - ▶ Comply with CDPS discharge permit
  - ▶ Protect workers



# Industrial Pretreatment Program

- ▶ Pretreatment Program
  - ▶ Cities of Littleton and Englewood
  - ▶ 100 square mile service area
  - ▶ 19 Connecting Districts or Municipalities
  - ▶ Required by EPA under the Clean Water Act
  - ▶ Required by CDPS Discharge Permit



# Industrial Pretreatment Program (cont.)

- ▶ Pretreatment Program Elements
  - ▶ Industrial Wastewater Permits (18 total)
    - ▶ Nine categorical industrial users (CIU)
    - ▶ Nine significant industrial users (SIU)
  - ▶ Sector Control Programs
    - ▶ Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG)
    - ▶ Petroleum Oil, Grease, and Sand (POGS)
    - ▶ Trucked and Hauled Septage
  - ▶ Industrial User Characterization
    - ▶ Industrial Waste Surveys
    - ▶ Inspections
