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20	WHEREAS, following its review of the applications, the board found that the
21	application for a project at the Weston Masonic Lodge meets the following Standard and
22	Discretionary Criteria:
23	1. The Weston Lodge is in the Main Street Historic District;
24	2. The grant is for two of the qualifying types of projects: façade work and maintenance;
25	3. All elements of the application were completed;
26	4. The proposed project has a positive visual impact on the character of the district; and

28	WHEREAS, the board found that the application for the Littleton Creamery
29	meets the following Standard and Discretionary Criteria:
30	1. The Littleton Creamery is in the Main Street Historic District
31	2. The grant is for four of the qualifying types of projects: design assistance, façade work,
32	maintenance, and other improvements
33	3. All elements of the application were completed, with the exception of the number of contractor bids
