**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, APPROVING A POLICE RECRUIT TRAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD TO USE THE JEFFERSON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND LAKEWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT'S COMBINED REGIONAL ACADEMY FOR RECRUIT POLICE OFFICER TRAINING.**

**WHEREAS**, the Littleton Police Department desires to use the regional academy to send five non-certified recruit police officers for up to six months of training;

**WHEREAS**, the regional academy provides the staff and all of the necessary classroom instruction, testing and evaluation of recruits; and

**WHEREAS**, the regional academy is recognized by the State of Colorado Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) Board;
