At your request, a background investigation was conducted on the above named establishment and the above named parties. The investigation included a check of Colorado Bureau of Investigation records. No derogatory information was discovered.

The records of the Littleton Police Department were also searched and the following incidents at this location were reported:

On 10/07/16 a customer attacked patrons and staff members with a Samurai sword. He was detained until police arrived, and was subsequently arrested. He and his friend purchased a total of 9 drinks in the bar. (LPD Case # 16-5177)

On 9/4/17 Officers responded to a patron unwilling to pay his bill. He was subsequently transported to detox due to his high BAC (.249) It was later determined that he was served four drinks while inside the bar. (LPD Case # 17-4468)

On 9/11/17 an intoxicated male arrived at the bar and was refused service. He was later transported to detox because he failed to leave the bar when asked by staff to do so. (LPD Case # 17-4591)
