14	No member of the city council shall at any time be entitled to or shall receive any remuneration		
15	whatsoever for any service or duty performed or any power exercised under the authority		
16	conferred by this section.		
17 18	Section 3: Title 1, Chapter 9, Section 1-9-2 of the Littleton City Code shall be

20	Section 4: Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or		
22	phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the

25	phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences,		
26	clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.

28	Section 5: Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in		
29	conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the		
30	repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
