9 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
10 COLORADO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 23 SERIES
11 OF 2017 KNOWN AS THE “ANNUAL APPROPRIATION
12 BILL” FOR ALL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES OF THE CITY
13 OF LITTLETON, COUNTIES OF ARAPAHOE,
14 JEFFERSON AND DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO,
15 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2018
16 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018.

18 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 23, Series of 2017 established the annual
19 appropriation for municipal purposes for the City of Littleton, Colorado, and

21 WHEREAS, as amended by Ordinance No. 42, Series of 2017 established the
22 annual appropriation for municipal purposes for the City of Littleton, Colorado, and

23
24 WHEREAS, appropriations have theretofore been made for the expenditures of
25 monies pursuant to said budget; and

27 WHEREAS, the necessity of receiving and expending additional monies from the
28 various funds could not have been reasonably anticipated during the time of adoption of the
29 budget and appropriation of funds in accordance therewith;

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
33 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

35 Section 1: The budget of the City of Littleton for the fiscal year beginning
36 January 1, 2018, and ending December 31, 2018, is hereby amended by additions to the
37 following fund:

1 **Section 2:** The provisions of the annual appropriations Ordinance No. 23,
2 Series of 2017, amended by Ordinance No. 42, are hereby amended with the total of all fund
3 expenditures amended to \$87,539,237.

5 **Section 3:** Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or
6 phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the
7 validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it
8 would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or
9 phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences,
10 clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.

12 **Section 4:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in
13 conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the
14 repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

18 of the City of Littleton on the 6th day of March 2018, passed on first reading by a vote of 7 FOR
19 and 0 AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center, Bemis Library, the
20 Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.

22 2018, in the Council Chambers, Littleton Center, 2255 West Berry Avenue, Littleton, Colorado,
23 at the hour of 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard.
