7 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,**
8 **COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH**
9 **THE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT REGARDING REIMBURSEMENT**
10 **FUNDING FOR THE MINERAL STATION AREA FRAMEWORK PLANNING**
11 **PROCESS**

13 **WHEREAS**, the city council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other
14 governmental bodies to furnish or receive government services, to make or pay charges for such
15 services and to enter into cooperative or joint activities with other governmental bodies;

16
17 **WHEREAS**, the city had been awarded funding of Seventy Five Thousand
18 Dollars (\$75,000) for the development a light rail station area plan through the Congestion
19 Mitigation and Air Quality grant to the Regional Transportation District (RTD) from the Federal
20 Transit Administration (FTA);

22 **WHEREAS**, RTD's contractual processes were amended during the Mineral
23 Station planning process so the project was no longer eligible for funding through FTA, and
24 RTD will now provide the city's reimbursement funds for the Mineral Light Station Area
25 Framework through RTD itself in the amount of Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000);

27 **WHEREAS**, the Intergovernmental Agreement details the agreement between the
28 city and RTD and is a requirement for reimbursement funding for the Mineral Station planning
29 project;

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31 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**
32 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

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34 The Intergovernmental Agreement with the Regional Transportation District
35 (RTD) regarding funding for the Mineral Light Rail Station Area Framework is hereby approved.
