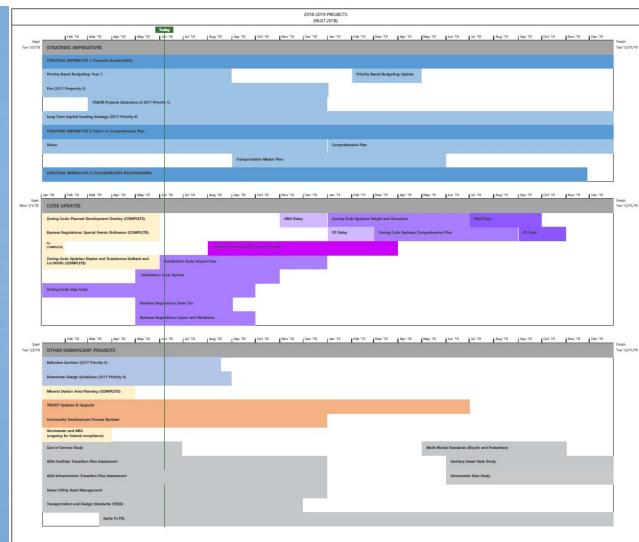

Strategic Imperatives

- I: Financial Sustainability
 - Fire: Election in November
 - Long-term Capital Funding: 5yr plan reviewed
 June 5th
 - Priority Based Budgeting: Model preview in August

Strategic Imperatives

- II: Vision to Comprehensive Plan
 - Vision: Consultant has met with >10 groups
 - Study Session Sept. 11th
 - Transportation Master Plan: Fall 2018
 - Comprehensive Plan: 2019



Strategic Imperatives

- III: Collaborative Relationships
 - Inventory of Relationships
 - Three Categories: Internal, Community, Regional
 - Aim to continue expanding all categories
 - specific focus on regional relationships and transportation

- Code Updates
 - Prioritized through the end of the year

- Transportation Planner (two year term) \$204,250 (2018-2020)

Impact Fees Fund

Transportation Master Plan - \$150,000

- Capital Projects Fund
 - Santa Fe and Mineral Concept Design and Traffic Signal Structural review -\$400,000

 - Elati and Promise Park playground improvements \$34,000
- Impact Fees Fund
