| 20 27 28 29 | Section 1: Section 54, 55 and 57 of the city charter are hereby amended and section 56 is deleted as follows: |
| 30 | Sec. 54. Appointment; EVALUATION. |

The Council shall appoint a City Attorney who shall be the legal representative of the City and who shall advise the Council and City officials in matters relating to their official powers and duties. The City Attorney shall be an attorney at law ELIGIBLE TO BE admitted to practice in Colorado and have a minimum of two years of legal experience. The Council may provide the City Attorney with such assistants as the Council may deem necessary. All attorneys who reside or maintain offices in the City shall be given first consideration for appointment. COUNCIL SHALL ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR THE CITY ATTORNEY. COMPENSATION FOR SPECIAL COUNSEL SHALL BE ESTABLISHED THROUGH THE ANNUAL BUDGET PROCESS. |
| 42 43 | The Council shall establish compensation for the City Attorney, his or her assistants and special counsel. THE COUNCIL SHALL EVALUATE THE CITY |

1 ATTORNEY NOT LESS THAN ANNUALLY. The City Attorney shall serve at

- 4 The City Attorney or the DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY shall:

- 6 B. Supervise the drafting of all ordinances and other legal documents.

- 25 ATTORNEY IN SPECIAL CASES to take charge of any litigation or to assist the

- shall be fixed by the Council at the time of employment.

Section 2: Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or

phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.

7 Section 3: Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in
 8 conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the
 9 repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
