The Planning Commission finds that the Downtown Littleton Design 36 Standards are consistent with and help implement city code and the Citywide 37 38 Plan. 2. The Planning Commission hereby adopts the Downtown Littleton Design 39 Standards with the following conditions: 40 a. the comments proposed as modifications in the Bryant Flink 41 Architecture & Design memo dated July 9, 2018, excluding #8, be 42 incorporated; and 43 b. the other edits as discussed in the meeting herein also be incorporated 44 45 as collected by staff. 46
