# **Role of the City Council**

Charter amendments are a public policy decision:

- Council decides the appropriate public policy
- Staff implements in accordance with direction given



#### Ordinance No. 27-2018

Amend Section 58 pertaining to the municipal court to change the title of judge to Presiding Municipal Judge and provide for council confirmation of judges appointed by the Presiding Municipal Judge.

- Pro: Charter will reflect separation of powers and proper title of municipal judge
- Con: Change to the existing charter
