Policy Question

Does city council support amending city code to bring it in line with state law?

- This would limit the number of marijuana plants per residence
- Add a definition for residential property

State Law

- House Bill 17-1220
 - Allows for 6 plants per *resident* 21 years old or older
 - Maximum of 12 plants per *residence*

Current City Code

- Limits the maximum number of plants per person 21 years of age or older to 6
- Does not limit the maximum per *residence*
- No definition for residential property in this section
- Contains other restrictions (building codes §4-1-5(I))

Staff Analysis

Staff analysis:

- Pros:
 - In line with state
 - Limits the number of plants allowed per residence
- Cons:
 - Change to the code

Request of Council

Does city council support amending Title 6, Chapter 4 of the Littleton City Code to:

- Update the number of marijuana plants allowed per residence to 12
- Add a definition for residential property
