

  - County Line \$2,000,000 (Phase 1 & 2)
  - Aberdeen \$1,100,000 (Phase 1)
  - Ridge Road \$1,875,000
  - Aberdeen \$1,100,000 (Phase 2)
  - Belleview Corridor Improvements \$2,500,000
- ADA Transition Plan Improvements \$250,000/Year
- Downtown Reconstruction \$3,500,000
- Intersection Capacity Improvements (i.e. Additional Turn Lanes) -\$1,200,000/Year
