It is important to note, however, that this application is subject 35 to the Downtown Neighborhood plan, which also references design and character elements to be met for this location. Also, in the future, any new development application for an expansion of 36 the footprint of an existing building in this location would be subject to these design standards as 37 38 specified in the Littleton Downtown Design Standards. Additionally, any future sign permit application would also be subject to these standards. 39 40 The Planning Commission hereby adopts the extension of the boundary of 41 Subdistrict 3 in the Downtown Littleton Design Standards. 42 43 44 45 INTRODUCED, READ AND ADOPTED at a regularly scheduled meeting of the
