- The creation of this committee stems from City Council's third strategic imperative of building collaborative relationships

Mission

- Mission: To support the City Council's vision statement with thoughtful, considerate and insightful recommendations, suggestions and feedback, on matters of City policy that directly impact the attraction and retention of young residents and employees.
- Goals/Objectives:
 - Increase engagement demographic
 - Participate in Envision Littleton
 - Provide input from the demographic on policy matters

December 2020	Council Review and potential committee extension
