20 21 22 23 24	WHEREAS , the City of Littleton, South Suburban Park and Recreation District, and Centennial Water and Sanitation District entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for Management, Operations, and Maintenance of the South Platte River Site on June 6, 2006, as amended by a letter dated September 1, 2011 ("First Amendment"), which provides that no water-based recreation activities are allowed on the South Platte Reservoir; and
25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, the IGA and the First Amendment are herein after collectively referred to as the "Intergovernmental Agreement;" and
29 30 31 32 33	WHEREAS, South Suburban Park and Recreation District is now requesting permission to install memorial benches at five locations along the trail on the south side of the South Platte Reservoir walking trail. The locations, bench descriptions, and construction methods are depicted on Exhibit A, attached hereto.
