300: Shall the City of Colorado Springs Home Rule Charter be amended to establish a Council-Mayor form of municipal government for the City of Colorado Springs, and in connection therewith, provide for the election of the Mayor by the city's voters; transfer the direction and supervision of all departments, divisions, offices and agencies from the City Manager to the Mayor; provide the Mayor with veto authority over municipal legislation; establish the Mayor's authority to appoint municipal executive and judicial officials; and provide that the Mayor's current place on City Council be taken by an additional at-large member of Council, beginning at the city's regular election in 2011?"
