#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE LITTLETON POLICE DEPARTMENT, DENVER POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND THE BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES.

WHEREAS, the Littleton Police Department desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Denver Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives to submit firearms evidence into the BrassTrax System for correlation on the National Integrated Ballistic Information Network; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding will help the Littleton Police Department reduce gun crime thereby enhancing community safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

The Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Littleton, the Denver Police Department, and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives is hereby approved.
