**ORDINANCE 11-2019: FIRST INTRODUCTION AMENDING THE WASTEWATER
UTILITY ORDINANCE REGARDING THE INDUSTRIAL PRETREATMENT
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the cities of Littleton and Englewood jointly own a wastewater treatment plant in Englewood that services both cities and several sewer district customers, and the plant is operated for the cities by South Platte Water Renewal Partners; and

WHEREAS, in order for the plant to operate within EPA and State of Colorado permit standards each time the plant's discharge permit to the South Platte River is renewed a review and update to the local limits for industrial users is necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of both cities to adopt new local limit standards for industrial pretreatment to preserve the quality of the South Platte River, maintain the plant at the highest performance levels, and protect workers and the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1: The City of Littleton adopts the industrial pretreatment standards for the wastewater facility operated by the South Platte Water Renewal Partners as approved by the Littleton/Englewood Wastewater Treatment Plant Steering Committee on February 28, 2019.

Section 2: The adopted table of standards is:

Section 3: Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.

Section 4: Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
