7 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO,**  
8 **REQUESTING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF**  
9 **COLORADO EXPLORE AMENDING TITLE 1 AND TITLE 31 OF THE**  
10 **COLORADO REVISED STATUTES SO THAT MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS**  
11 **MAY BE CONDUCTED USING APPROVAL VOTING FOR**  
12 **NONPARTISAN ELECTIONS**

14 **WHEREAS,** the City of Littleton's Election Commission recommended to City  
15 Council that City Council consider the method of Approval Voting for nonpartisan elections; and

16  
17 **WHEREAS,** City Council has considered the method of approval voting for  
18 nonpartisan elections; and

19  
20 **WHEREAS,** City Council, while not endorsing the method of Approval Voting,  
21 does believe that the General Assembly of the State of Colorado should explore amending Title 1  
22 and Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes so that municipalities may consider the method of  
23 approval voting for their own elections.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**  
26 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

28 That City of Littleton does hereby request that the General Assembly of the State  
29 of Colorado consider amending Title 1 and Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes so that  
30 municipal elections may be conducted using Approval Voting for nonpartisan elections, and that  
31 the Secretary of State promulgate rules as necessary for implementation.
