6 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
7 **LITTLETON, COLORADO, ENDORSING AN APPLICATION BY THE**
8 **CITY OF LITTLETON FOR DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS**
9 **(DOLA) GRANT FOR CENSUS 2020 CITIZENS ENGAGEMENT**

11 **WHEREAS,** The City of Littleton will participate in the nationwide Census that
12 is occurring 2020; and

13
14 **WHEREAS,** To get the most complete and accurate count of hard to contact
15 residents in Littleton, a team of staff members have created a 2020 CENSUS PLAN; and

17 **WHEREAS,** Littleton, as of 2015, has at least 47,588 residents. If the population
18 has increased to over 50,000, the city becomes eligible for additional federal funding and
19 programs not currently available.

21 **WHEREAS,** Community Development and Communications will work together
22 in the 4th quarter of 2019 to create a Complete Count Committee to assist in the
23 groundwork during the census campaign in 2020. Proposed participants include but are
24 not limited to: South Metro Housing Options, Littleton Promise, Next Generation
25 Advisory, Committee, South Suburban Parks and Recreation, Littleton Public Schools,
26 Parent Teacher Associations, and Littleton Immigrant Resource Center; and

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF**
29 **THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

31 1. The City of Littleton approves the grant application for Census 2020 funding
32 from DOLA for public engagement during Census 2020.
