RE: Liquor license Show Cause Hearing

Licensee,

On July 10, 2019, the Littleton Licensing Authority determined that there was probable cause to believe you are in violation of the Colorado Liquor Code and the Littleton City Code as noted below. Because you opted not to enter into a Stipulation, Agreement, and Order with the City Prosecutor, you are hereby notified that the Authority has scheduled a public hearing to consider the possible revocation or suspension of your Hotel & Restaurant liquor license. These possible violations are in regard to an incident that occurred on March 7, 2019. A copy of the incident report is attached.

Colorado Liquor Code 44-3-901(1)(a): "To sell, serve, give away, dispose of, exchange, or deliver, or permit the sale, serving, giving, or procuring of, any alcohol beverage to a visibly intoxicated person or to a known habitual drunkard."

Littleton City Code 3-2-7(F) (formerly 3-2-10(F)): "Sale To Intoxicated Persons: It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, serve, give away, dispose of, exchange, or deliver or permit the sale, serving, giving, or procuring of any fermented malt beverages, malt, vinous, or spirituous liquors to or for any person visibly intoxicated or known to be a habitual drunkard."

The public hearing is scheduled for Wednesday, October 9, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber of the Littleton Center, located at 2255 West Berry Avenue, at which time you may be present to show cause, if any, why the license should not be suspended or revoked.
