ARTS UNIFY COMMUNITIES

67 PERCENT of Americans believe "the arts unity our communities regardless of age, race, and ethnicity" and 62 PERCENT agree that the arts "helps me understand other cultures better"—a perspective observed across all demographic and oconomic categories.

ARTS IMPROVE INDIVIDUAL WELL-BEING

63 PERCENT of the population believe the arts "lift me up beyond everyday experiences," and 73 PERCENT say the arts are a "positive experience in a troubled world."

ARTS SPARK CREATIVITY AND INNOVATION

Creativity is among the TOP 5 APPLIED SKILLS sought by business leaders, per the Conference Board's Ready to Innovate report with 72 PERCENT saying creativity is of high importance when hiring, Research on creativity, shows that Nobel laurestes in the sciences are 17 TIMES MORE LIKELY to be actively negated in the arts than other sciences.

ARTS DRIVE THE CREATIVE INDUSTRIES

The Creative industries are arts businesses that range from norprofit museums, symptonies, and theaters to for-profit film, architecture, and design companies. A 2017 analysis of Dun & Braditiver data course 673,656 BUSINESSES in the U.S. involved in the creation or distribution of the arts—4.0 PERCENT of all businesses and 2.0 PERCENT of all employees.

ARTS HAVE SOCIAL IMPACT

University of Pennsylvania researchers have demonstrated that a HIGH CONCENTRATION OF THE ARTS in a city leads to higher civic engagement, more social cohesion, higher child weltare, and lower poverty rates.

ARTS FOR THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF OUR MILITARY

The arts heat the mental, physical, and moral injuries of war for military servicementhers and Veterars, who rank the creates arts therapes in the TOP 4 (OUT OF 40) interventions and treatment. Across the military confinuum, the arts promote resilience during predeplyment, delpolyment, and the reintragration of military servicementhers, Veterans, their families, and congresser into communities.

ARTS IMPROVE HEALTHCARE

Nearly ONE-HALF of the nation's healthcare institutions provide arts programming for patients, families, and even staff. 78 PERCENT deliver these programs because of their healing benefits to patients—shorter hospital stays, better pain management, and less medication.


