RE: Hotel & Restaurant Liquor License Renewal Hearing

Dear Licensee:

On June 16, 2021, you submitted an application to renew your Hotel & Restaurant liquor license. The Licensing Authority will be considering whether to approve or deny the application based on the following:

Littleton City Code 3-2-12 (B): "The chairperson of the authority, or in his or her absence the vice chairperson, is hereby authorized to grant liquor or beer or medical marijuana center license renewals as provided herein. All applications for renewal shall initially come before the chairperson and may be approved by him or her so long as all applicable fees have been paid, all required procedures have been complied with, and no information regarding alleged violations of the Colorado liquor and beer codes or amendment 20 of the Colorado constitution or violations of this code have been referred to him or her by the police department or otherwise."

As part of the renewal procedure, information was obtained from the city's Finance Department regarding unpaid taxes and fees in the amount of \$30,545.31 and their attempts to contact you regarding said balance, up to and including the filing of lien against your business in an attempt to recoup monies due the city.

The scheduled pre-renewal hearing is schedule at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 14, 2021, and will be virtual via Zoom. While you may be present at this meeting, no testimony will be heard. If the Authority sets your renewal application for a public hearing, you will have an opportunity to offer testimony at that time.
