50                   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HISTORICAL**  
51 **PRESERVATION BOARD OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

53                   **Section 1.** The historical preservation board does hereby recommend that City  
54 Council establish the period of historic significance for the historic district for the years 1870 –  
55 1975.

56                   **Section 2.** The historical preservation board does hereby recommend to City  
57 Council that 69 of the 82 structures in the historic district be designated as contributing properties,  
58 as specifically described in Exhibit C, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by this  
59 reference.

61                   **Section 3.** The historical preservation board does hereby recommend that City  
62 Council approve the proposed application for a Downtown Historic District as specifically  
63 described in Exhibit A and depicted on a map in Exhibit B, which are attached hereto and made a  
64 part hereof by these references.
