Full Plan:

- Action Plan Implementation \$750,000 (split between three cities)
- Bridge House \$6M (Implementation)

- STEP 1 = Coordinator
 - In partnership with Tri-Cities and County
- STEP 2 = Coordinator begins implementation
 - Analyze funding and partnership opportunities
 - Work with county, each city, and key partners
 - Continue Tri-Cites Homelessness Policy Group
