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### **PURPOSE:**

Does city council support approval of a five-year lease with Pitney Bowes for a postage meter and related postage services to the city.

#### **SUMMARY:**

The city entered into a 51-month lease with Pitney Bowes in 2011 and renewed a 48-month lease in 2016. The clerk's office reviewed proposals from two other local companies and Pitney Bowes; Pitney Bowes was able to provide a lower per-month rate.
