**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
COLORADO, AUTHORIZING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE
AGREEMENT WITH MILE HIGH FLOOD DISTRICT REGARDING
DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINAGE AND FLOOD CONTROL
IMPROVEMENTS FOR RANGEVIEW GULCH FROM SOUTH PLATTE
RIVER TO PRINCE STREET**

WHEREAS, the Council may, by resolution, enter into contracts with other government bodies to furnish or receive governmental services, to make or pay for charges for such services and to enter into cooperative or joint activities with other government bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Littleton desires to make improvements to Ridgeview Park based on recommendations from the 2023 City of Littleton Integrated Water Resources Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Rangeview Gulch planning study “Outfall Systems Planning for Lower Dad Clark Gulch and DFA 0068” dated 1991 provided recommended alternatives for Rangeview Gulch connection from City Ditch to South Platte River; and

WHEREAS, the City of Littleton entered into an agreement with Mile High Flood District (MHFD) for design and construction of drainage and flood control improvements for Rangeview Gulch from South Platte River to Prince Street on June 3, 2025; and

WHEREAS, MHFD Capital Improvement Program requires the sponsoring jurisdiction to match funds a minimum of 50%; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the design and construction of the infrastructure and drainageway improvements are not finalized at this time; and

WHEREAS, the City of Littleton's cost share set forth in the agreement is \$750,000; and

WHEREAS, additional Agreements are anticipated to finalize project terms and financing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. The Littleton City Council hereby approves the first amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement by and between the City of Littleton and Mile High Flood District for the Design and Construction of Drainage and Flood Control Improvements for Rangeview

Gulch from South Platte River to Prince Street, in substantially the same form as Exhibit “A” and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement.
